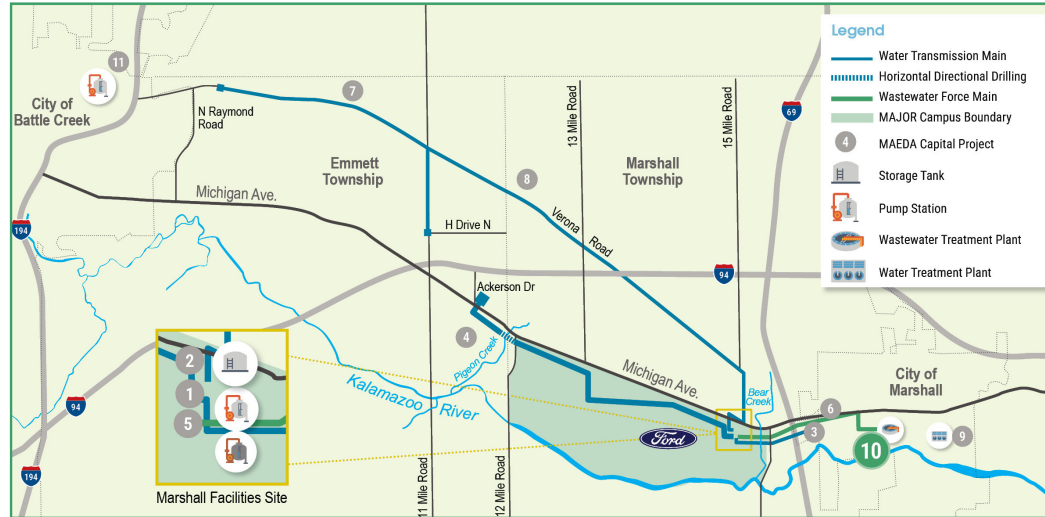


Marshall Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements

Investment in water and wastewater infrastructure expansion is crucial for the health of our community as well as ongoing efforts to protect our lakes, rivers, and streams.



The City of Marshall's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) will undergo an upgrade as increased wastewater flows originating from the MAJOR campus will need to be treated. The upgrade will include a new headworks facility used for screening the wastewater as it enters the plant and a new equalization basin that stabilizes the flows before they enter treatment. The headworks facility will replace the existing inflow structures that have long been in service. The new flows will be conveyed to the plant via the Sanitary Sewer Force Main (Project #6).
