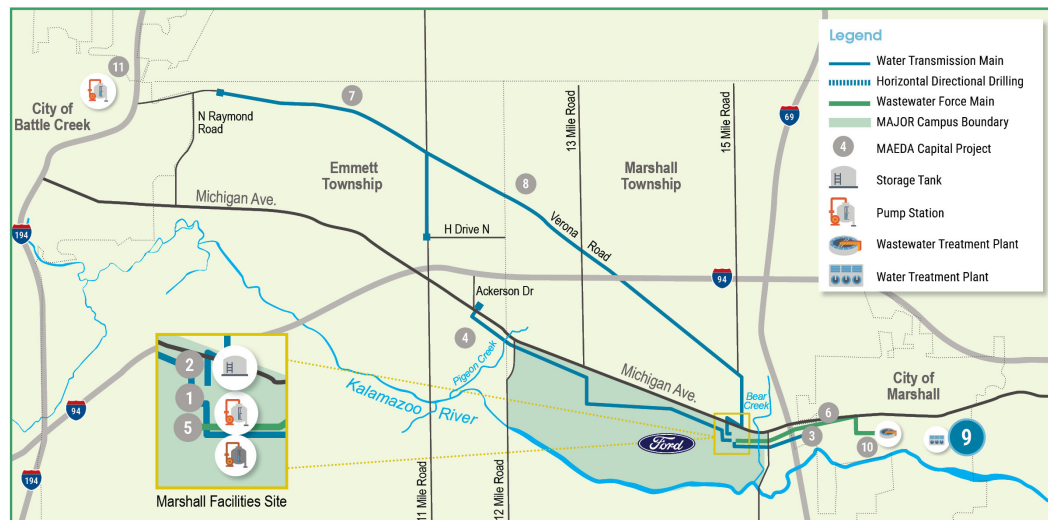


Marshall Water Treatment Plant Improvements

Investment in water and wastewater infrastructure expansion is crucial for the health of our community as well as ongoing efforts to protect our lakes, rivers, and streams.



The Marshall Water Treatment Plant (WTP) Improvements project consists of filter vessel rehabilitation and media replacement, a new standby power generator and upgrades to the water supply well house piping and valves. Electrical, controls and chemical feed improvements are also included.

The planned WTP improvements will bolster the existing treatment system for the additional water demand associated with the increased industrial water demand from the customers at the MAJOR campus increasing service capability and reliability of the City of Marshall's water treatment infrastructure.

Key Project Features

- ◆ Filter vessel rehabilitation and media replacement.
- ◆ Water supply well house piping upgrades and valve replacement.
- ◆ New natural gas fed standby power generator.
- ◆ Electrical, controls and chemical feed improvements.
